We have worked with the Sheriff's Department in Michigan to assist in developing thier peer to peer programs.

7. Long Term Sober Living. Many of our Warriors, when they complete residential treatment, need additional support and structure. Sober living provides this. This allows our warriors an environment where they can go out and work, volunteer, integrate back into the community while also have the safety net of a sober housing structure. Funding assists in some of the costs of their housing.
